

Zhouying JIN is a senior researcher and professor at the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences (CASS); Founder and former Director of the Center for Technology Innovation and Strategy Studies of CASS; President and Founder of the Beijing Academy of Soft Technology.

She graduated from University of Science and Technology of China (USTC); a researcher, Research base of a Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS); a researcher, Research Institute of a

National Defense Science and Technology; Deputy Chief Engineer of Changchun Electric Industrial Administration; Vice secretary-general, China enterprise Directors (Managers) Association of State Economic Committee of China. From 1988, she has served at CASS. At the same time, since the beginning of the 1990s, she served for the China S863 Plan, has been appointed as the Strategy Experts Team Leader for the S863 Plan (China High-Tech Research & Development Plan for 2001–2010) by the Ministry of Science & Technology.

At present, she is Chair of China Node of millennium project (MP), Chair of China Chapter of World Future Society (WFS), Fellow of the World Business Academy (Ojai, CA, U.S.), Global Advisory Board member of Ethical Markets Media (U.S.), Member of the editorial board or Advisory Committee of several magazines, such as "AI & Society" (UK) etc.

She was a Member of Professional Committee of Chinese Academy of Social Sciences; Guest Professor of University of Science and Technology of China (Hefei), Tsinghua University (Beijing), Hohai University (Nanjing); Academic member of Shanghai Academy of Systematic Science; Adviser for Soft Power Research Center of Jinan University; Visiting professor of Case Western Reserve University (Cleveland, U.S.A), University of Nebraska-Lincoln (Lincoln, U.S.A), University of Aix-Marseille III (France); Senior Research Fellow, Institute for The Future (U.S. CA, Menlo Park); IC2 Institute (The University of Texas at Austin); Special researcher, Institute of Science and Technology policy of Japan; Member of The Club of Rome EU-Chapter (CoR-EU) (Brussels); Chair of the "Future 500 China"; Global knowledge leader (E-100) etc.

The major fields of her recent research are future research, soft technology and soft environment, long-term strategy management, Innovation, etc. She was invited by more than twenty countries and over 40 universities, research institutes and international conferences to present about her theory of soft technology, soft environment and the future of humanity. For instance she was invited as one of the ten "world thinkers" and as a speaker for the first 'Festival of Thinkers' with ten Nobel Laureates in 2005.

She is listed as the Global Foresight Professionals as an only Chinese mainland futurist (http://www.globalforesight.org) and listed as the world's top female futurists (http://rossdawson.com).

Among her publications, there are 21 monographs, 6 translated books, more than 20 joint publications; more than 30 important research reports, diagnostic and consulting reports from over 40 companies, and hundreds of important papers.
